Recommendations:

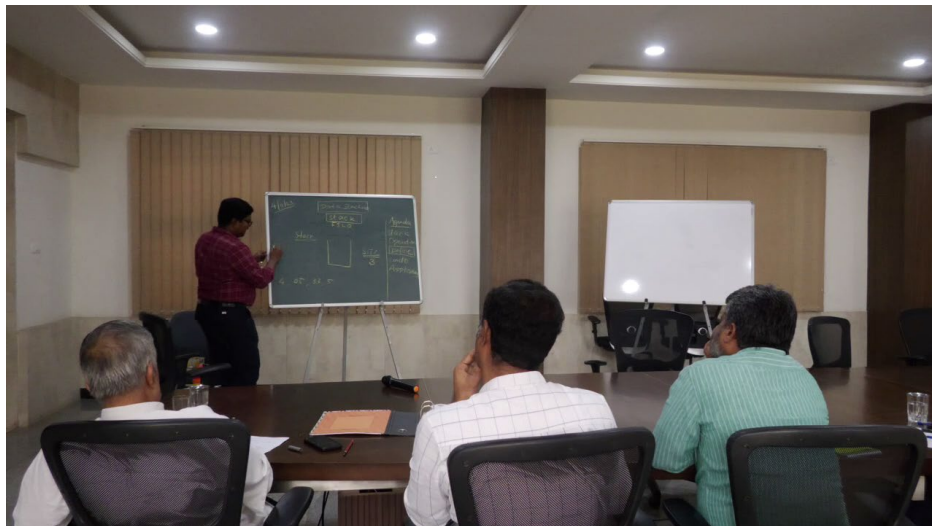
Professional Development Workshops: Conduct workshops focusing on specific areas identified for improvement, such as questioning techniques and classroom management.
