<u>Annual Report for the Academic Year 2014 – 2015</u>

- ➤ The **Bhoomi Pooja** for the institution was performed on **9**th **September 2013** with the blessings of trustees, heads of institutions, elders and well wishers.
- The college was dedicated to technical education on 2nd July 2014 in the presence of its trust board members and all heads of institutions of PSG.
- ➤ The Administrative Block was inaugurated by honorable Union Minister for Parliamentary Affairs and Department of Personal Shri Venkaiah Naidu on 31st August 2014 in the presence of our trustees.
- The college is recognized by AICTE and affiliated to Anna University Chennai. Majority of college seats were filled within the first two days of counseling.
- > Our Institution offers five UG Programmes viz: Civil, CSE, EEE, ECE and Mechanical.
- ➤ **Governing council** meeting was held on **30**th **December 2014** and valuable guidance from the honorable members were obtained.
- ➤ Anna University Affiliation committee visited our campus on 23rd March 2015 for studying the faculty position and infrastructure readiness for the next academic year 2015 2016; the process went on smoothly.

Orientation Programme

The Orientation programme was conducted on 31st July and 1st August 2014. Mr TN Sivakumar, Managing Director, Electronics and Control Corporation, Coimbatore, Mr R Sandeep of Amazon Technologies Bangalore and Mr C Prakash of Ashok Leyland Chennai delivered motivational and enlightening lectures to students.

Student and faculty data

The overall student strength of the college stands at 299, which includes 114 girl students.

- A total strength of 180 students stay in the hostel of which 70 are girl students.
- ➤ Eight Research Scholars who were guided by our faculty were awarded PhD degrees during the current academic year.
- At present **22 scholars are pursuing** research with our college faculty.
- ➤ The college has **38 dedicated faculty members** out of which **18 faculty members** are with **PhD qualification**.

Research

- Already one project titled "Alternate Materials for Machine Tool Structures funded by DST" is being jointly done with PSG College of Technology.
- Our faculty have published twenty one research papers, with high impact factor in various International journals.
- The following faculty have prepared research proposals for submission to the funding agencies.
 - o **Dr Chandramohan G**, "Improvement of Mechanical Properties of Medium Carbon Steel by Boriding Process" to Aeronautical Research Development Board (ARDB), New Delhi.
 - Dr Balaji K, "Development of photosensitive epoxy polymers for various indigenous technological applications" to Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, New Delhi.
 - Dr Ezhil J, "Novel 3 D patterning using electrophoretic deposition for micro battery applications" to Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, New Delhi.

I Semester Results

- ▶ PSG Institute of Technology and Applied Research is able to perform exceedingly well with a record pass percentage of 98.66%; out of 298 students who appeared, 294 students cleared all the subjects.
- A notable aspect in this regard is 100% pass percentage in Mechanical Engineering Department and the highest average CGPA was 8.13 in the ECE Department.

Infrastructure

- ➤ Equipment worth Rs 4.3 Crores have been added, during the current year in order to meet the academic requirements for the first two years.
- Our RO plant with a capacity of 8000 I / day was commissioned on 25th March, 2015; it supplies quality drinking water to all our essential services including the mess.
- In a similar way, **STP-Sewage Treatment Plant** is also **ready for commissioning** and the same will be **put into service**, with effect from the next month.
- ➤ Three more academic blocks with about 2.5 lakh square feet will be ready by Dec 2015. It is planned to add a, library and museum complex, spread over 1 lakh square feet by Dec 2016.
- A hostel complex with 2 lakh square feet, a guest house with 18,000 square feet along with faculty quarters spread over 50,000 square feet will be ready by May 2016 for use by students and staff.
- An important unique world class facility that will be added in our institution during next year, is the convention hall with a seating capacity of 1450 covering an area of 70,000 square feet, the estimated cost being Rs.30 Crores. The total cost of the above on-going infrastructure development work will be around Rs.130 Crores.

Centres of Excellence

- The following centers of excellence specifically developed to make our students industry ready are being planned to be established in our institution with an estimated investment of Rs One Crore.
- 1. **FESTO- Pneumatic Automation Laboratory** in the dept. of Mechanical Engineering.
- 2. **National instruments Virtual Instrumentation Laboratory** in the dept. of ECE.
- Keysight Technologies Laboratory in the area of Circuits and Devices in the dept. of ECE.

Faculty Development Programmes

- 19 faculty were trained in the area of Micro Teaching by Dr R Krishnaveni, Professor dept of HR of PSGIM at Anaikatti of PSG Institutions on 31st December 2014 along with Prof Vivek.
- Our faculty and non-teaching staff numbering 17 visited Ashok Leyland, Hosur on 2nd and 3rd January 2015 and observed the manufacturing practices of automotive components.
- A workshop on "Lesson plan for class work" was organized on 10th
 January 2015 in board room for the faculty members, by our senior faculty.

Departmental Association Activities

 The department association activities were inaugurated by eminent experts in the respective fields and twelve lectures were organized by the associations for the benefit of our students.

Industrial visits

- The students of ECE visited ZF Wind Power Ltd, Coimbatore on 30th January 2015.
- ➤ The students of CSE visited Sakthi Auto components Ltd Pallagoundampalayam on 6th February 2015.
- ➤ The students of EEE visited L&T Coimbatore on 6th April 2015.
- The dept. of Civil Engineering organized a visit to Water Treatment Plant at Siruvani on 10th April 2015 for their students.
- ➤ The dept. of Mechanical Engineering also arranged an industrial visit to Hyundai Motors at Chennai on 18th April 2015 for the benefit of the students.

Value added courses

- ➤ Hands on training were conducted for the ECE students on 12th January 2015 on the topic "Basics of circuit design using Multisim"; sixty of our students and faculty underwent the course.
- ➤ Department of **ECE** conducted a value added course on "**Sensor Interface** using LabView" with faculty and students of PSG College of Technology, on 1st and 8th of March, 2015; sixteen of our students attended the programme.
- ➤ Department of CSE conducted a value added course titled "HTML, CSS & Adobe Dreamweaver CS5" on 14th March 2015; forty seven of our students were benefitted.

- ▶ Dept of ECE conducted hands on training on "PSPICE Circuit Simulation" on 10th of April 2015; Mr Manoj kumar of Entuple Technologies was the expert; our students numbering forty participated. The first year students from PSG Tech along with their faculty conducted the programme and it was well appreciated.
- ➤ Three faculty from PSG Tech including Dr R Nadarajan have helped our CSE students by way of special lectures.
- A 3D printer has been donated by PSG Management with support from Festo for the Innovation Laboratory and students can make their hard prototypes using the same.

Based on student's feed back

- Our laboratories, particularly Programming Laboratory is kept open in the Evenings and Sundays for use by students.
- ➤ The **Library book issue**, modalities have been **revised** so that the **utilization** of library resources is **maximum**.

College Events

The college staff and students celebrated the **Independence Day**, and **Republic Day** with **addresses** by **Mr Irusupillai**, veteran patriot of Coimbatore by **Dr Jayanthashree Balakrishnan** of PSG College of Arts and Science. They really touched the hearts of our students and kindled their inspiration.

- ➤ Engineer's Day was also celebrated by all our students and staff on 15th September with a special address by Mr Anand Purushotaman CEO of Payoda Technologies, where he highlighted the importance of soft skills for our students.
- Women's day "Vatsalya" meaning motherly love and affection was well organized with all our girl students and women staff participating on 11th

- March, 2015. Dr Bhuvaneswari of PSGIMSR delivered an inspiring talk on the subject "Work Life Balance for Women".
- ➤ Hostel day was celebrated on 27th February 2015 in a grand manner, with 100% participation by all the inmates. Several cultural events marked the highlight of the evening.

Cultural Events

Our annual cultural event, ADVAYA meaning "One without a Second" was organized on 7th February 2015 with over 220 students exhibiting their unique talents in the domains of Music, Dance Treasure Hunt, Rangoli, etc. It turned out to be an important event to unleash the potential of our students.

Industry – Institute Interaction Meet

One day industry institute interaction workshop was arranged on 21st March 2015. Mr N Muralidharan, GM-HR and Mr C Prakash, GM Technical, Ashok Leyland were invited as chief guests. Lectures on "Behavioral Competency" and "Global Warming" were delivered to our students.

Award of Scholarships

- ➤ On behalf of **PSGG** Trust, **Smt. Prema Govindaswamy** awarded scholarships to **ten** students of our college from various branches. The **scholarship value** was **Rs.10**, **000** each per student.
- ➤ Mr SK Anand, another Senior Alumnus of PSG College of Technology arranged for scholarship to eight more students of our college, the amount being Rs. 10,000/- each.

Sports

 Mr Karthik Vedachalam, our I Civil Engg student won Two Gold Medals in 50m and 100 m Butter-fly Stroke Swimming competition and One Silver Medal in 50 m Breast Stroke Swimming competition in the Anna University Inter Zonal Tournament.

- Indoor games facilities including Table Tennis/Caroom/ Shuttle Badminton/Professional Gym Equipment two no's have been set up for use both by our boys and girls. Recreation room, common rooms are also ready for use by our students.
