Annual Report for the Academic Year 2015 – 2016

1. Student and Faculty Data

- > The overall student strength of the college stands at 637, which includes 261 girl students.
- > A total strength of 362 students stay in the hostel of which 136 are girl students.
- Four Research Scholars who were guided by our faculty were awarded PhD degrees during the current academic year.
- > Two of our faculty have completed their PhD degree programme.
- At present **20 scholars are pursuing** research under the guidance of our college faculty.
- The college has **55 dedicated faculty members** out of which **23 faculty members** are with **PhD qualification.**

2. Academic Performance

- ➤ PSG Institute of Technology and Applied Research had performed exceedingly well with a pass percentage of 97.32%; out of 299 students who appeared, 291 students have passed all the subjects in April-May 2015 Semester Examinations.
- ➤ In Nov-Dec 2015 Semester Examinations, pass percentage of students was 91.02%; out of 635 students who appeared, 578 students passed all the subjects (before revaluation).
- A notable aspect in this regard is 100% pass percentage in Ist year ECE & CSE and the highest SGPA was 9.62, secured by Ms Sreejhaa Suhumar in the ECE Department.

3. Major Infrastructure

- Three more academic blocks with about 2.0 lakh square feet will be ready by April 2016. It is planned to add a, library and museum complex, spread over 1 lakh square feet by April 2017.
- A hostel complex with 2 lakh square feet along with faculty quarters spread over 50,000 square feet will be ready by July 2016 for the use of students and staff.
- An important unique world class facility that will be added in our institution during next year, is the convention Centre with a seating capacity of 1550 covering an area of 70,000 square feet, the estimated cost being Rs.30 Crores. The total cost of the above on-going infrastructure development work will be around Rs.130 Crores.
- > 12 laboratories, at a cost of Rs 3.82 crores have been established in our campus for the forthcoming academic year.

4. Events

- The Orientation programme was conducted on 31st July and 1st August 2015.

 Mr Anand Purushothaman, CEO, Payoda Technologies, Coimbatore was the Chief Guest. Several industry experts motivated our students.
- ➤ CSE Block seminar hall and ISTE Chapter was inaugurated by Founder Trustee, Shri.G.R.Karthikeyan, on 4th January 2016. Dr R Subbaian, Former VC, Bharathiar University has delivered a lecture on "Be an Engineer, not merely an Engineering Graduate".
- ➤ Governing council meeting was held on 2nd March 2016 and valuable guidance from the honorable members were obtained.
- Anna University Affiliation committee visited our campus on 19th March 2016 for studying the faculty position and infrastructure readiness for the next academic year 2016 2017; the process went on smoothly.
- The following center of excellence was established by the dept. of Mechanical Engineering.
 - FESTO Pneumatic Automation Laboratory in the dept. of Mechanical Engineering was established and inaugurated on 20th May 2015.

5. Workshop / FDP's/Guest Lectures organized

- Our faculty and staff numbering 32 have attended the workshop on "Well-being in the working environment" organized on 19th June 2015 by Mr V Ravindran, MD, Jay Jay Liners.
- Micro-teaching in theory and laboratory courses were conducted during June and December 2015, which has helped 36 faculty members to improve their teaching performance.
- The department association activities were inaugurated by eminent experts in the respective fields and twenty five lectures were organized by the associations for the benefit of our students.
- > Ten workshops and value added courses were organized by our faculty for our students in various departments.

6. R&D Activities

- Already one project titled "Alternate Materials for Machine Tool Structures funded by DST" is being jointly done with PSG College of Technology.
- Our faculty members have published twenty nine papers, with high impact factor in various International journals.
- ➢ Research project submitted by Dr. J. Ezhil, AP/Physics has been sanctioned by the DST Young Scientist scheme (Start-up grant) Engineering Sciences. (Project cost Rs.30 Lakhs)

7. Other major events

- ➤ The NSS unit of PSG iTech, organized a camp on 8th December 2015 at Ganapathypalayam Government Middle School. 46 NSS volunteers along with NSS coordinators Mr P Chinnaraj AP/Mathematics and Ms V Vilasini AP/CSE have organized the camp.
- > 75 students from PSG iTech have participated in the Organ Donation Camp, jointly organized by SNR & Sons Trust on 19th March 2016.
- > 32 students and 2 faculty have participated in one day NSS camp titled "Save Heritage Perur Temple Project-2016".
- > Students Wellness Centre was inaugurated on 1st April 2016. Nearly 60 students participated.

8. Placement Training Programme

- Placement Training Programme was conducted for the II BE CSE, Mech and Civil Engineering students on 28th December, 2015. Alumni and students of PSG Tech have given valuable tips regarding placement.
- Industry Academia Conclave which was organized on 20th February 2016 by all the departments. Expert speakers were invited from various industries to our institution.

9. Scholarship

➤ 18 students were offered merit-cum-means scholarships and we have planned to increase it to 30 this year, the scholarship amount being Rs 10,000/- per head.

10. Sports

- Our students 12 in number, won 3rd prize in Throwball organized by Park College of Engineering in 5th Park CET Alumni Trophy State level Inter Engineering.
- Our students Mr.S.A.Sakthi Vignesh & Mr.C.Naveen Kumar (Dept. of Mechanical) won 3rd place in Sepaktakraw organized by PSG College of Technology (PSG Tech Trophy).
- Our girl students have got 1st place in Table Tennis, Athletic, Discus throw, Shot Put, Javelin and badminton in the Anna University intra-zone tournament.

11. Green Initiatives

- ➤ Dr. R. Sivakumar (HOD Chemistry) and Mr D. Vivek (AP-PSGIMS) and team visited Organic farming at Gobichettipalayam on 18th December 2015.
- As a part of Green Initiatives, **Solar PV cells of 400kW capacity are being installed** on the roof tops of **administrative and engineering blocks** for meeting the power demands, partially in our institution.

12. Tarangini

Our college has also brought out a quarterly magazine "Tarangini" for local circulation among our students and staff, where articles prepared by our students are compiled and shared with our community.
