PSG Institute of Technology and Applied Research Annual Report for the Academic Year 2016- 2017

1. Academic Performance

➢ PSG Institute of Technology and Applied Research had performed exceedingly well with a pass percentage of 95.07%; out of 954 students who appeared, 900 students have passed all the subjects in November - December 2016 Semester Examinations. "Our College stands first among 520+ affiliated Engineering colleges in Anna University for fifth consecutive semester examinations, from its inception".

2. Major Infrastructure

The total cost of the on-going infrastructure (Library, museum and auditorium) development work will be around Rs.50 Crores; covering a square feet area of 2 lakh.
