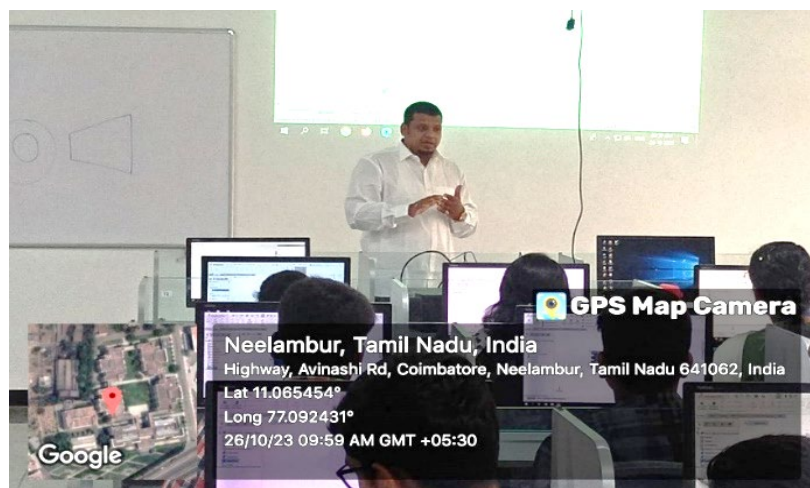

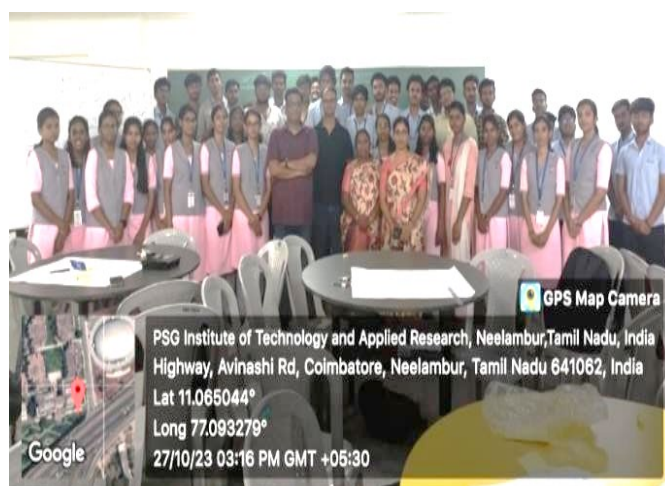
1. K. Senthilkumar, Associate Professor in Mechanical Engineering, welcomed all the participants and the resource person.

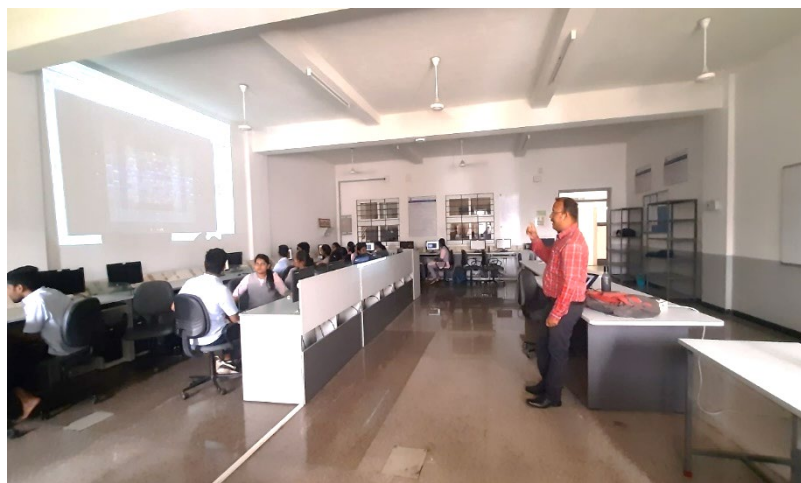

1. The workshop aimed to provide participants with an in-depth understanding of the Cadence Tool, a leading software suite used in electronic design and automation, and its applications in the field of the Electronics Industry.
2. The Cadence Workshop was organized to facilitate knowledge sharing and skill development among faculty members and students in the Department of ECE.
3. Over the two days, the workshop covered various aspects of Cadence, from its fundamental concepts to advanced applications in Digital and Analog Electronics.

1. The program started with an introductory session by Dr. M. I. Abdul Aleem, Head of the Department of Civil Engineering. Ar. G. Tamilvanan, Principal of PSG Institute of Architecture and Planning, was present during the inauguration.
2. Er. Rajendran, the resource person, delivered a comprehensive overview of different forms of brick masonry, including bonds, arches, and domes.
3. Within the laboratory setting, students were organized into groups consisting of individuals from both the Civil and Architecture Departments. The teams constructed brick masonry with English, Flemish, and rat trap bonds, flat and segmental arches, semicircular arches, corbelling, brick jolly works, twisted columns, and domes.
4. On the second day, Er. S. Rajendran provided detailed explanations of building and architectural processes, with a particular focus on their practical implementation in renowned monuments such as the Tanjore Great Temple. The session covered a variety of brick-built roofs and arches.
5. Dr. N. Divyah, Assistant Professor in the Department of Civil Engineering, delivered the vote of thanks.



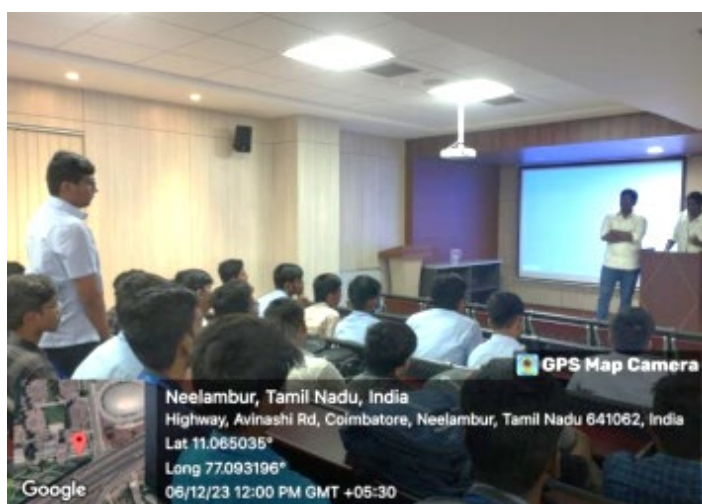

1. This talk focused on innovation and entrepreneurship among students. About 1.7 million children are prone to congenital hearing loss per year.
2. He mentioned that Impulse is a low-cost hearing aid for congenital hearing loss, which is a non-surgical method. Normally, this congenital hearing loss is treated by open skull surgery called cochlear implantation, in which the magnet is fixed inside the skull, and the hearing source is connected externally.
3. He said that it has many disadvantages, which include brain infections, fluid leakage in the brain, facial paralysis, and nerve damage.
4. The method also has some limitations. For instance, a person who undergoes this surgery should not use mobiles, cannot actively participate in sports, cannot take MRI scans, and the surgery needs a very large amount, and the source should be updated every 5 years.
5. To overcome this, Backyard Creators introduced IMPULSE, which costs less than 50,000 rupees and works on the principle of electromagnetic wave stimulation.
6. This device is validated by Audiologists and ENT Research Foundation, which also has 2 international patents, and about 50 children have been treated so far, and the device is towards success.

5. Finally, it was an efficient technical talk that helped the students improve their skills in Cloud Native.

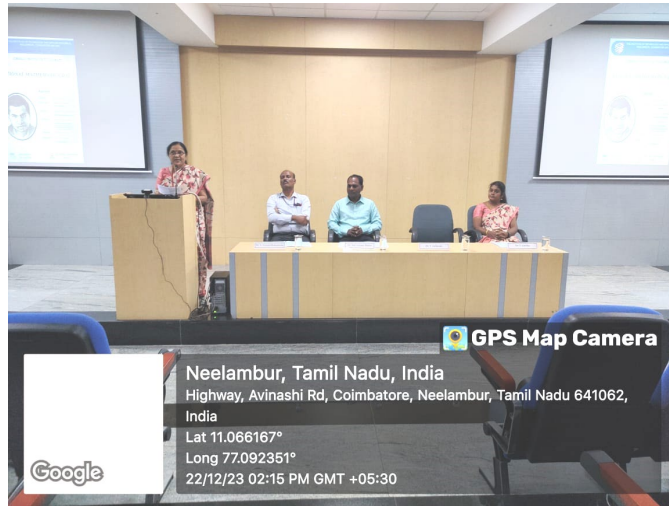
